

Group Reservation Policies

For Group fieldtrips

1. Group participation is for 12 children and at least one chaperone. For more than 12 children an additional charge of \$5 per child applies, and an additional chaperone is required.
2. Parents dropping children off to the fieldtrip are welcome to stay during the duration of the class, and will either be considered a chaperone and actively participating in the class OR are welcome to sit in our waiting lobby. Please keep discussion in the lobby to a low volume so as not to disturb the class in session. ☺
3. Homeschooling groups that use this option should bring school aged children only, unless the class is specifically for preschool aged children. This ensures that the class will run smoothly and all children will feel happy participating.
4. A \$25 deposit is due with your group registration form in order to reserve your date.

Studio Use for Private Groups

1. Group leader making reservation is responsible for making sure the studio is left in the condition that you find it upon entering.
2. Group leader and parents are responsible to make sure that children do not behave in a disruptive or dangerous manner, and for ensuring the safety of the children in the group as well being respectful of the studio space and property.
3. Snacks should be kept at the low table in the studio. Let us know if you'll need additional tables.
4. This studio use option is intended for social groups only and may not be used for birthday parties. If you are interested in hosting a birthday celebration at PGH, please ask us for a birthday registration form and policy sheet.
5. Homeschooling groups using this option can bring children of any age.
6. A \$25 deposit is due with your group registration form in order to reserve your date.
